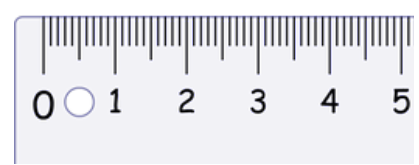
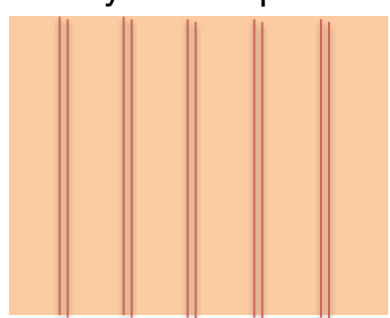
Hedeby windowpane linen plaid – 4mm (.16 inch)



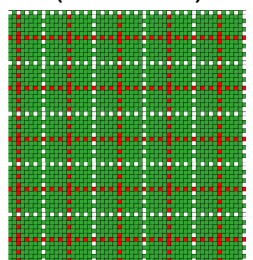
Hedeby wool and linen plaid – 12X17mm



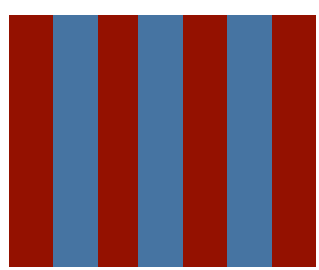
Hedeby S27 stripe – 8mm (.32 inch)
